The LST CAMRA area is well connected by road and rail. All of the towns have connecting rail stations and several of the surrounding villages can be accessed by bus.

CAMRA is committed to supporting affordable and accessible public transport and has teamed up with the Better Transport Campaign to raise awareness and champion for improved services



## Is the bus expensive?

The Government has extended its £2 single bus fare initiative until 31st December 2024 which is great news. Day Saver and Multi Traveller tickets makes bus travel a flexible and good value option.

Of course if you have a bus pass what can be better than free!

## What about trains?

West Midlands Trains operate services across the LST Branch area.

Connected to the mainline by multiple providers, rail travel offers easy access to the whole country, giving the opportunity to join locally, but travel nationally. A range of railcards offering up to 1/3 off travel are available - including student / two together / and veteran options



## Plan my Journey

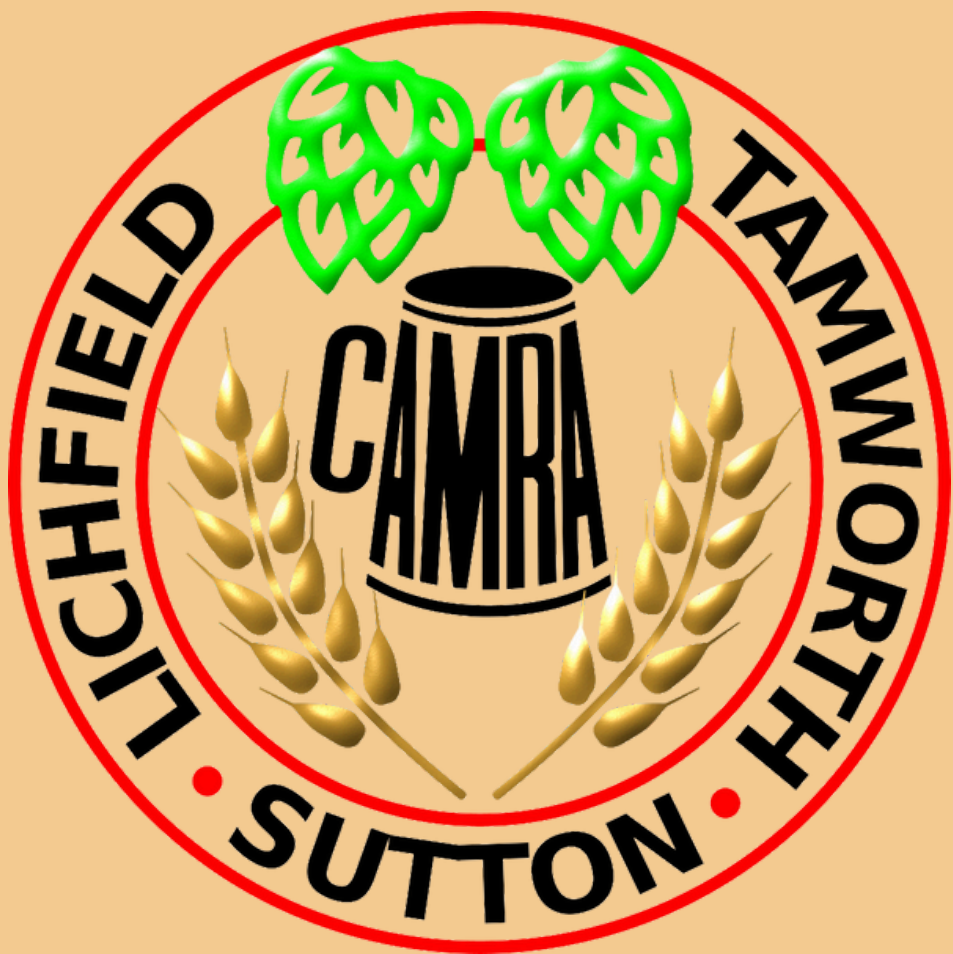
